

Public Netbase is committed to the exploration of the relations between culture and technology, art and society, science and politics. Its World Wide Web Server was awarded the Prix Ars Electronica 95.

Ranging from Basic HTML to Advanced JAVA/VRML, the Public Netbase education program plays an important role in fostering the growth of a lively Internet scene and an understanding of the implications of new communication and information technologies.
